DEFINITIONS:

Academic Dishonesty - Copying from another student's work, using a AI generated website, copying directly from the Internet

Assault - An intentional threat by word or act to do violence to another person, coupled with apguardian ability to do so, and doing some act that creates a well-founded fear in another person that such violence is imminent without subjecting him or her to physical attack. Assault, physical injury, means a physical pain or an impairment of physical condition.

Dangerous Instrument – Means any deadly weapon or anything that, under the circumstances in which it is used, attempted to be used, or threatened to be used, is capable of causing death or serious physical injury. Any pointed, sharp, or blunt instrument which has no legitimate educational purpose for the student at school, and items that closely resemble weapons (look-alikes) or operate similarly, such as pellet guns, BB guns and starter pistols. Also prohibited is the use as a weapon of any article or substance not normally considered to be a weapon, for example; hunting knives, laser pointers, cigarette lighters, scissors, rocks, pens, pencils, rubber bands.

Defiance of School Authority – Not following directions of faculty or staff, failure to observe rules, and openly challenging authority.

Disrespect - Not showing appropriate respect for the school building, the school staff or others.

Disruption of Education – Any act which substantially disrupts the orderly conduct of a school function, behavior substantially disrupting the orderly learning environment or poses a threat to the health, safety and/or welfare of students/faculty and staff.

Dress Code – (Inappropriate) - Clothing or grooming styles that present a health or safety hazard or distraction which would interfere with the educational process.

Due Process - Meeting where students and sometimes guardians meet with the principal to hear an explanation of the evidence the school authorities have and an opportunity for the student to present his or her explanation of the incident.

Fighting – (Mutual altercation) - At least two students participating in a physical combative altercation.

Harassment/Intimidation – Using repeated unwelcome remarks to annoy, demean, or ridicule another; or forcing another to do something, or preventing another from doing something, by threatening, bullying, or making him/her afraid. Any form of unwanted, deliberate, or offensive behavior that has been asked to be stopped.

Non-Compliance - Student refusal to follow directions even after repeated requests from staff.

Profanity - Use of words that are inappropriate for school.

Replica - Any device that looks like or is intended to look like a gun regardless of what it is made out of.

Sexual Harassment – Violation of School Board policy prohibiting sexual harassment. Consists of unwelcome sexual advances, requests for sexual favors and other inappropriate verbal, written, or physical contact of a sexual nature when such conduct substantially interferes with a student's academic performance or creates an intimidating, hostile or offensive school environment. It includes, but is not limited to, verbal harassment or abuse, pressure for sexual activity, repeated remarks to a person with sexual demeaning implications, unwelcome or inappropriate touching, or suggesting or demanding sexual involvement accompanied by implied or explicit threats.

Threatening Behavior Report – Report filed with district safety officer and local law enforcement informing them of the facts in the incident and what actions were taken by the school.
